

## 2nd Grade Supply List

- 1 package of #2 pencils (pkg more than 10) (see note below)
- 1 pkg of 3 or more pink pearl erasers AND/OR pencil top erasers
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
- 4 plastic folders with pockets and brads 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green, and 1 orange
- 2 boxes of 24 count crayola crayons
- 1 bottle of glue
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box of markers (10 classic colors)
- 1 box of colored map pencils
- 1 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 2 tablets of handwriting practice paper (D'Nealian Ruled  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $\frac{1}{4}$ ")  
(these may be difficult to find; just get something close to this size)
- 1 canister of sanitizing wipes
- 1 Box of Gallon size Ziploc bags (GIRLS ONLY)
- 1 box of sandwich or snack size ziploc bags (BOYS ONLY)
- 1 pkg of play-do
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 1" 3 ring binder (preferably white)
- 1 supply box (5"x8")
- 1 pkg of manilla paper (BOYS ONLY)
- 1 pkg of colored heavyweight construction paper (GIRLS ONLY)
- 1 watercolor paint
- 1 backpack (no wheels)
- 1 snack item (large box or bag of crackers, graham crackers, cereal, pretzels, etc.)

\*\*If you choose not to purchase the plastic/poly folders you will need to purchase **extra** paper folders. The paper folders **will not** last all year. Sometimes the plastic folders do not make it a whole year. I suggest buying these when school supplies are first put out at the stores to ensure you get the plastic in the correct colors.

\*\*I would also prefer Ticonderoga pencils. Yes they are more expensive, however, usually with the inexpensive pencils they do not sharpen well and break easily.

\*\*Your child will also need paper, pencils and crayons throughout the year at home to do homework and projects.
